

Announcement of Agreement for Establishment of a Joint Venture

Yokohama, Japan and Hsinchu, TAIWAN – Tera Probe, Inc. (“Tera Probe”), one of the world’s largest wafer probing service companies, and Powertech Technology Inc. (“PTI”), one of the world’s leading assembly and test houses, have come to final agreement on establishment of a joint venture company (“JV”) and signed the Joint Venture Agreement today.

While Tera Probe and PTI signed Memorandum of Understanding on the establishment of JV for wafer test services in Taiwan on June 27, 2008, Tera Probe together with PTI officially decided today to establish “晶兆成科技股份有限公司” in Chinese, “TeraPower Technology Inc.” in English by the end of August, 2008 in Hsinchu County, Taiwan.
